
Buying tickets 2025 Grad

First Round: Each grad can get 4 free tickets and 6 paid (\$7.50/ea) tickets


Second Round: Any remaining seats will be available for \$7.50/ea

These screen-shots are what it looks like on a computer, it will be slightly different looking on a phone.


- 1. Go to Ticketmaster.ca and search for "Forest Lawn High School Graduation"
 - Click on the event




2. Click on "Unlock" and use Student ID as passcode.




3. Use the Drop-down to choose how many tickets you want (remember the maximum is 10).




- 4. Click on the map and use the "+" sign to zoom in on the section you would like. Blue seats are available, Grey seats are not. When you choose a seat, indicate whether it is a 'free ticket' or a 'paid ticket'.
 - In this example 6 tickets were bought, 4 were free, and 2 were paid, bringing the total to \$15



- 5. If you try to claim more than the maximum amount (4 free, 6 paid) you will see an error message when you click on 'next'.
- 6. If you are not already logged in to a Ticketmaster account, you will be prompted to log in now.
- 7. If you are getting only free tickets, click "place order". If you are purchasing any tickets, click 'add new card' and enter your credit card information. A credit-debit card can be used if it is set up for online purchases.

9. Now I suggest logging into your Ticketmaster account on a guest's phone (one of the people who needs the tickets) and downloading them to a wallet app on their phone. In your Ticketmaster account chose to 'manage tickets' and there is an option to **download to a wallet app**. All the tickets can be held on one person's phone as long as they are sitting as a group. Below are the icons for the wallet app on iPhone and Android.
