## Acquiring Graduation Ceremony Tickets (Jubilee Auditorium)

### How to make a Ticketmaster account

Why do I need an account to reserve tickets? Note: Grads do NOT need a ticket. Babies do need a ticket.

- All grads have the opportunity to reserve 4 free tickets at the Jubilee starting April 27. To RESERVE your grad tickets (you/your parent/guardian) must have a Ticketmaster account.
- If you are reserving tickets for someone else, they ALSO need a Ticketmaster account in order for you to TRANSFER them to their account.

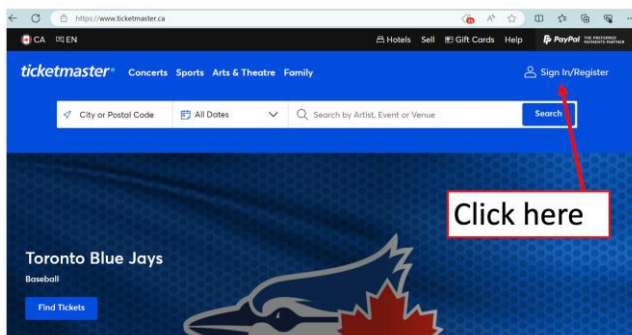
**On April 27<sup>th</sup> – 4 tickets can be reserved**, and the seats chosen.

- Please be aware that a credit card is need to purchase any remaining tickets on May 22<sup>nd</sup>. In this round of sales, provided seats are still available, extra tickets can be purchased by each grad.

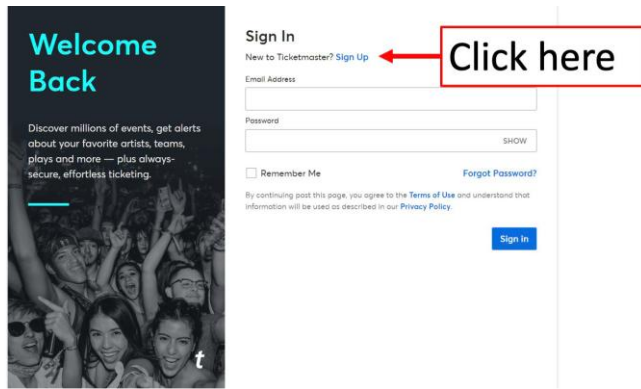
Steps:

1. Go to Ticketmaster.ca and search for “Forest Lawn High School Graduation”

- Click on the event



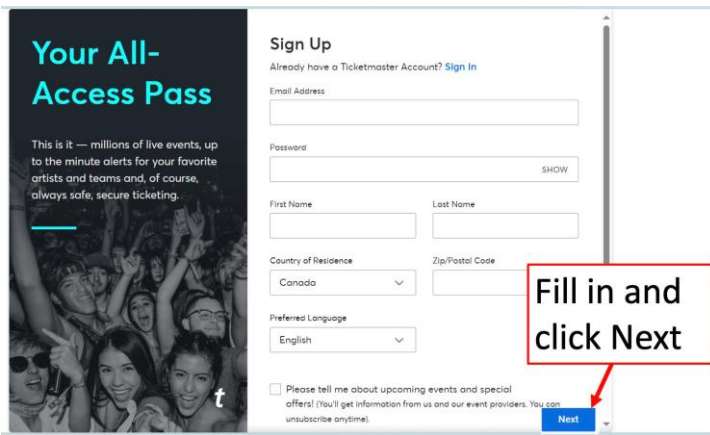
2. Click on “Sign Up” to create a new account.



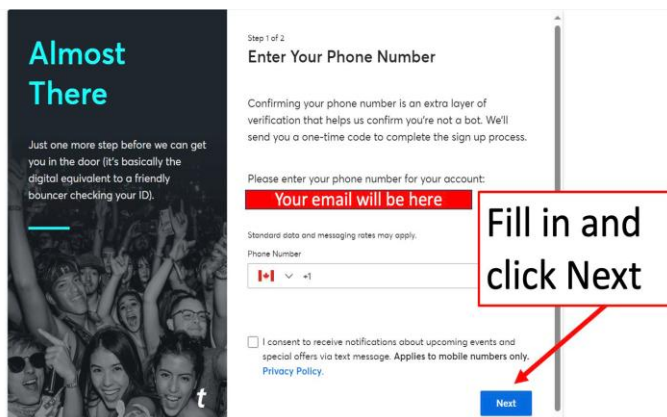
Type in the required information. You can use your school email, or personal email. Click 'next' at the bottom of the screen.

Which email should I use?

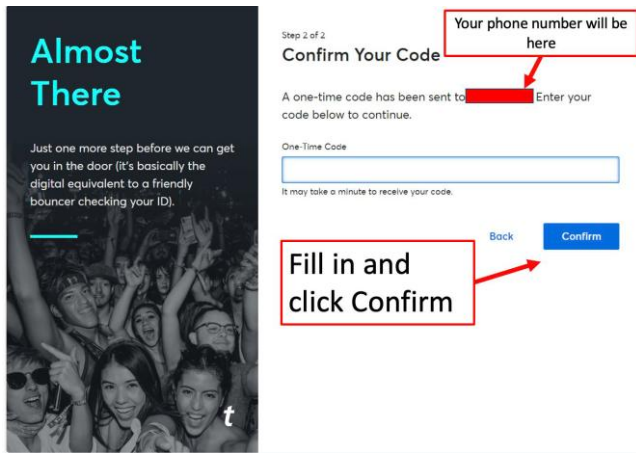
- Ticketmaster is used to purchase tickets for many events in Canada and the USA.
- Many people use it at some point in their life for concerts and events.
- If you think you may need it in the future, use your personal email otherwise your school email is ok.



4. Enter your phone number and click “next”. You will get a text message with a code to enter on the next screen.



5. Enter the code from your phone and click “confirm”.



6. Now on the homepage for Ticketmaster you will see “My Account” on the top right corner.

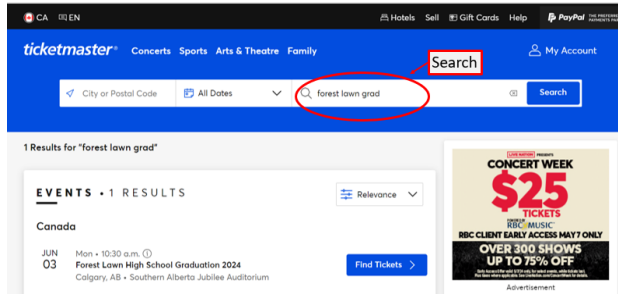
## Graduation Ceremony Tickets - How to RESERVE your Ceremony Tickets (grads don't need one)

**First Round:** Opens April 27 – closes May 19. Each grad can reserve 4 tickets. Grads do not need a ticket. Babies do need a ticket.

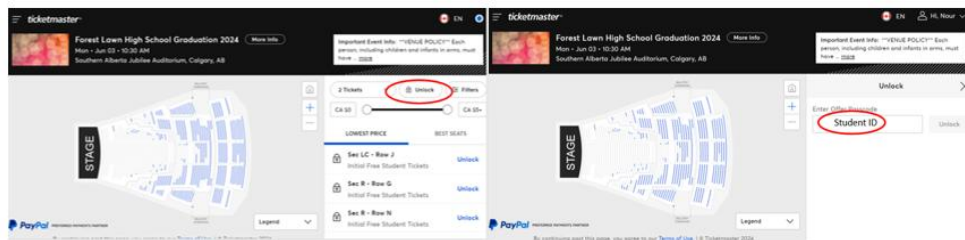
**Second Round:** Opens May 22 – Closes May 29. Any remaining tickets will become available for \$10/each.

Below are screen-shots are what Ticketmaster looks like on a computer, it will be slightly different looking on a phone.

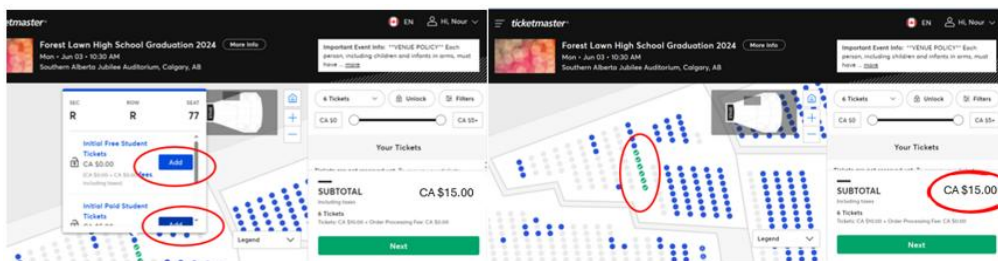
1. Go to Ticketmaster.ca and search for “Forest Lawn High School Graduation”
  - Click on the event



2. Click on “Unlock” and use **Student ID** as passcode.



3. Use the Drop-down to choose how many tickets you want (remember the maximum is 4). All tickets need to be reserved in one transaction so the guests can sit together.



4. Click on the map and use the “+” sign to zoom in on the section you would like. Blue seats are available, grey seats are not. As you pick your seats, they will become green. In the first round there will be no cost; **in the second round, tickets are \$10/each**
5. If you try to claim more than the maximum amount (4 free) you will see an error message when you click on ‘next’.
6. If you are not already logged in to a Ticketmaster account, you will be prompted to log in now.
7. Click “place order”. If you are purchasing any tickets (**second round only**), click ‘add new card’ and enter your credit card information. A credit-debit card can be used **if it is set up for online purchases.**

9. Now I suggest logging into your Ticketmaster account on a guest's phone (one of the people who needs the tickets) and downloading them to a wallet app on their phone. In your Ticketmaster account chose to 'manage tickets' and there is an option to **download to a wallet app**. All the tickets can be held on one person's phone as long as they are sitting as a group. Below are the icons for the wallet app on iPhone and Android.



## Graduation Ceremony – Details

The ceremony is an important part of your graduation. This is an event in which your family, friends, teachers, peers and community will formally recognize and celebrate your success. It takes place at the **Southern Alberta Jubilee Auditorium** (1415 - 14 Ave. NW) on **Friday, June 5, 2026**. **Students need to arrive at 9:00 a.m. to line up and prepare with teachers for the ceremony.**

The program consists of a processional, during which graduands, guests, and teachers enter the main auditorium in their academic gowns while the audience stands to receive them. This is followed by a program of messages, introductions and musical interludes. Each graduand crosses the stage to receive a certificate and congratulations from the Principal, Assistant Principals, Area 3 Director and a Calgary Board of Education Trustee. Lifetouch will take a picture of you as you receive your certificate.

As this is a formal ceremony, the audience is requested to dress in business attire, to pay respectful attention to the speeches and musical performances, and to remain in the auditorium until after the recessional. Friends and family are requested to refrain from cheering and giving flowers or gifts during the ceremony. They are asked to withhold their applause until each group of graduands has been presented.

The graduation ceremony is approximately **three hours in length** and is not suitable for young children. There is limited seating available for people with disabilities. The access and seating in the **Southern Alberta Jubilee Auditorium** is not suitable for those who may have trouble navigating stairs or sitting for extended periods.

**Parking is available at the Southern Alberta Jubilee Auditorium (1415 14 Ave NW – SE corner of 16 Ave and 14 Street NW beside SAIT and ACAD).** **There is a parking charge of \$7.00** but the C-Train SAIT station is close and also an excellent option.

**Graduands will enter the building line up at 9:15 am** to be organized by their designated teachers. Guests will not be permitted to enter the lower level of the Jubilee Auditorium. The doors for guest seating will open at approximately 9:30 am. **The processional (ceremony) will begin at 10:00 am sharp. If you are late, you will miss your entry into the ceremony.**

### **Recommended Timeline for the Morning:**

**9:00 am** Be on time. Plan your route and timeline before the morning of the ceremony. Expect traffic delays.

**9:15 - 9:45 am.** When you arrive, turn right, go the Alberta College of Art and Design Hallway to form the alphabetical lineup for the procession by **LAST NAME**. Your guests must enter the auditorium at this time, show their tickets **on their phone** and sit where designated.

**10:00 am** The **auditorium processional will take place. Remain standing** for O' CANADA and the INVOCATION - Please be quiet and respectful.

**12:30 pm** Return your stoles as you exit the auditorium seating area.

### **Ceremony Attire**

A dress, skirt and blouse, shirt and tie, dress pants, and dress shoes should be worn under the grad gown. Long dresses are not appropriate at the exercises, as this is an academic occasion. Corsages are not worn on academic gowns. Dress shoes should have comfortable heel for walking across the stage. If you wear a blazer, please leave it with your family as it will be very warm with the gown on.

**Graduands will NOT be permitted to take purses, hats, cameras, cell phones, iPods, air pods, earphones or other items into the ceremony.** Please leave these items with family or friends to avoid having to leave them behind in the gowning area. The school will not assume responsibility for the security of any student's personal items.

**Photographs:** At the stage, a professional photographer from Lifetouch will be taking photographs of each student with the Principal. These photographs will be available free of charge in June. Friends and family are requested not to interrupt the ceremony by coming to the front to take pictures. This disturbs the audience and prevents others from seeing and hearing their graduand's name being called.

**Graduation Gowns, Caps and Tassels**

Souvenir Graduation gowns, caps and tassels will be provided. You will be able to pick up your gown, cap and tassel on Friday, May 29<sup>th</sup>. Students will be called, down alphabetically, during period 1.

**Served Family Style to each table**

**Spring Rolls (Vegetarian)** – Light, flaky rolls stuffed with shredded vegetables and served with dipping sauce.

**Veggie Manchurian** Crispy vegetable dumplings made from finely chopped vegetables, lightly fried and tossed in a savory Indo-Chinese sauce with garlic, ginger, and mild spices.

**Chicken Wings – Salt & Pepper** Crispy chicken wings lightly seasoned with salt, cracked black pepper, and subtle spices, then tossed with sautéed garlic and green onions for a savory, aromatic finish.

**Meatballs – Sweet & Sour Sauce** Tender, oven-baked meatballs simmered in a classic sweet and sour sauce, combining tangy vinegar, mild sweetness, and savory notes for a balanced flavour.
